If the offender wants to complete the class at an agency outside the Pullman area, they may do so, so long as the agency is certified by the State of Washington. *The cost is approximately \$100.* The offender must pay that cost directly to the treatment agency. The class usually takes two days. The offender must provide proof of completion to the prosecutor's office AND must sign a waiver of confidentiality at the treatment agency, so the prosecutor's office can verify that the offender completed the class and when they did so.
