Whitman County Landfill/Transfer Station Asbestos Loads

Every Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) load must be accompanied by our “**Waste Shipment Record**” form fully completed and signed by the owner or Abatement Company and hauler(s) before asbestos will be accepted.

All loads of ACM (Asbestos Containing Material) must follow the packaging requirements for acceptance. The requirements for packaging of these materials are as follows:

Adequately Wet

Generators are responsible to ensure that ACM is adequately wet as required by regulation prior to packaging.

6 mil bags (55gal Max)

All ACM must be double bagged in a 6 mil bag (55 gal Maximum). Each bag must be sealed properly. Each bag must be labeled in compliance with the regulations.

Burrito wrapped asbestos must be double wrapped in **reinforced** 6 mil plastic. Burrito style wrapped asbestos must have the seams glued and taped so they do not leak During transportation or offloading. Burrito wrapped ACM must be labeled in several locations.

Labels must display the following information:

ADDRESS (where the waste was generated)
NAME OF GENERATOR
DATE WASTE WAS COLLECTED (BAGGED)
DANGER
CONTAINS ASBESTOS FIBERS
MAY CAUSE CANCER
CAUSES DAMAGE TO LUNGS
DO NOT BREATHE DUST
AVOID CREATING DUST

Torn or broken packaging

ACM with torn or broken packaging will be rejected. When unloading, if at any time your packaging rips, tears or is breached in anyway it must immediately be repaired. All transporters shall carry plastic, tape, and glue so the repair can be completed.

Adverse weather

During the winter months it is advised to call (509) 334-2400 before arriving at the Landfill/Transfer Station with ACM for disposal. This insures there is adequate access to the Limited Purpose Landfill.
